The Brookton Business Advisory Group (BBAG) is an advisory group that will operate for a period of 12 months, with the key focus to establish an incorporated body, such as a Chamber of Commerce or similar. If successful in fulfilling this initiative, the Council could then dissolve the BBAG and maintain a level of support to the newly formed Chamber of Commerce.

The intent of the BBAG is to support the collaboration between local businesses and promote economic opportunities. The primary objectives of this group is to:

- 1. Represent the interests of the local business community;
- 2. Drive economic vibrancy, activity and engagement across the local community;
- 3. Establish collaboration with the Shire and other stakeholders;
- 4. Pursue the formation of a local Chamber of Industry and Commerce with the assistance from the Shire; and
- 5. Identify, investigate and support implementation of strategies, tactics and initiatives in consideration of digital transformation and a new age of doing business.
