1.12.24 DECLARATION OF OPENING/ANNOUNCEMENT OF VISITORS

2.12.24 BUSINESS OF THE MEETING

2.12.24.01 BROOKTON RAILWAY STATION

The Shire of Brookton received a Request for a Special Meeting of Electors on 15th November 2024 from at least 5% of the number of electors under section 5.28 of the Local Government Act 1995.

This request seeks to discuss at a Special Meeting of Electors the Council decision to demolish the Brookton Railway Station and specifically:

That Council:

- 1. Rescind the decision, and or stay any further action on the demolition of the Brookton Railway Station; and
- 2. Form an independently chaired working group with terms of reference to include:
 - comprised of locals, experts, indigenous advisors and railway heritage groups;
 - to explore alternative outcomes other than demolition for the place including supplementary funding sources, building contract procurement options.
 - c) independent costing by a quantity surveyor of the cost to demolish and redevelop and compare to cost and community value of restoration.
 - d) develop a vision for community activation of the existing place beyond the most recent uses.

Under section 5.28 of the Local Government Act 1995, a Special Meeting of Electors is to be held on a day selected by the shire president but cannot be held more than 35 days after the receipt of the request.
